L A G G I N G E N T E R P R I S E S

AFTER STRESSING SUCCESSES SCORED IN 1956, THE ARTICLE SAYS THAT IT IS NOT A SECRET THAT PARALLELLY WITH KOLKHOZES AND SOURHOZES WHICH LAST YEAR ACHIEVED SERIOUS SUCCESSES, THERE ARE LAGGING ENTERPRISES ACHIEVING LOW YTELDS IN AGRICULTURE

AND CATTLE-BREEDING.

PRAVDA THEN DWELLS ON THE IMPORTANCE OF INNER RESERVES, OF PLANNING OF PLANTING, AND OF THE WORK OF SPECIALISTS.

POOR REPAIR OF MACHINES

MAIN ROLE IN PLANTING IS PLAYED BY MECHANIZERS OF MTS
AND SOURHOZES. MANY MTS HAVE OVERFULFILLED THEIR TASKS
CONCERNING REPAIR OF TRACTORS. HOWEVER, IN A NUMBER OF REGIONS,
PROVINCES, AND REPUBLICS, THE REPAIR OF TRACTORS, PLANTERS,
CULTIVATORS AND OTHER MACHINES IS CARRIED OUT WITH UTMOST
DELAY. MTS OF THE CHITINGKAYA, KEMEROVSKAYA, OMSKAYA REGIONS,

SERIOUSLY LAGGING IN THE REPAIR OF TRACTORS. LAGS IN THE

VIRGIN LAND DIFFICULTIES S
MTS AND SOVKHOZES IN THE VIRGIN LAND AREAS OF KAZAKHSTAN,
URALS AND SIBERIA, EXPERIENCE CERTAIN DIFFICULTIES IN THE
REPAIR OF MACHINERY. HERE A GREAT QUARTITY OF TRACTORS IS
BUSY WITH TRANSPORTATION OF GRAIN FROM DISTANT CENTRES.
SLUSH, LACK OF GOOD ROADS, ENORMOUS TENSION IN THE WORK,

SEED SITUATION IS BETTER THAN LAST YEAR, IT IS
NOT SATISFACTORY EVERYWHERE. CLEANING AND SEED-QUALITY CONTROL
ARE ORGANIZED WITH DELAY. IN SOME PLACES, IN VIEW OF EARLY

TODAY'S RUDE PRAVO EDITORIAL PUBLISHES AN EDITORIAL DEALING WITH SIROKY'S SPEECH DELIVERED AT THE MEETING OF CZSL. GOVERN-MENT WITH MEMBERS OF CENTRAL AND COUNTY NATIONAL COMMITTEES IN CONNECTION WITH THE PROBLEM OF DECENTRALIZATION.

THE FDITCRIAL FURTHER QUOTES EXCERPTS FROM SIROKY'S SPEECH STRESSING
THE IMPORTANCE OF DECENTRALIZATION AND ITS NECESSITY.
THE EVENTS IN HUNGARY PROVED THAT THIS WAY SET UP BY THE NATIONAL

#### 1. THURSDAY MORNING HIGHLIGHTS

(JAN 3 0600 0800 HRS) THE COUNCIL OF STATE HAS
APPROVED DECREES MAKING THE CITIES OF KRAKOW, POZNAN AND
WROCLAW INDEPENDENT OF THE VOIEVODSHIPS AND SETTING UP
CITY NATIONAL COUNCILS ON THE SAME LEVEL AS THE VOIEVODSHIP
ONES; INTRODUCING CHANGES INTO THE MILITARY PENAL CODE DETAILING
PUNISHMENT FOR DESERTION; GIVING THE CHURCH THE RIGHT OF
ITS JURISDICTION WHILE RETAINING FOR THE STATE THE RIGHT
TO INFLUENCE APPOINTMENTS. A NUMBER OF OTHER DECREES

#### BYDGOSZCZ TRIAL

(JAN 2 1204 2035 HRS 2010 COSZCZ) THE TRIAL OF THOSE
RESPONSIBLE FOR THE HOOLIGAN EXCESSES IN BYDGOSZCZ OPENED
ON JAN 2. THE DEFENDANTS ARE ACCUSED OF CREATING RIOTS,
SETTING FIRE TO A RADIO STATION, ATTACKING THE HQ OF THE
CITIZENS' MILITIA AND DEMOLISHING PUBLIC BUILDINGS. THE
MAJORITY OF THE ACCUSED ARE YOUTHS BETWEEN 17 AND 20. NEARLY
70 WITNESSES WILL TESTIFY. ON THE FIRST DAY OF THE TRIAL
STATEMENTS WERE MADE BY 3 OF THE ACCUSED, TADEUSZ GULCZ,
WALDEMAR MARCINIAK AND RYSZARD KOSIK, WHO REVOKED THE STATEMENT
HE MADE DURING THE INTERROGATION. THE TRIAL IS EXPECTED TO
LAST ANOTHER NINE DAYS. (SOUND RECORDING WAS BROADCAST BY
BYDGOSZCZ.)

(JAN 2 2000 HRS) INVESTIGATIONS OF THE CASE AGAINST FOUR WORKERS ACCUSED OF ATTACKING AND DISARMING A GUARD IN A SZCZECIN FACTORY HAVE BEEN COMPLETED. THE ACCUSED WILL FACE TRIAL IN THE MIDDLE OF JANUARY.

(JAN 2 2100 HRS) SECRETARY EDWARD OCHAB VISITED THE "BAILDON"
FOUNDRY. IN HIS SPEECH HE DID NOT CONCEAL THE FACT THAT THE

UNSUITABLE TEXTBOOKS, WHICH MAKE STUDY DIFFICULT EVEN FOR INTELLIGENT CHILDREN.

(JAN 2 2000 HRS WARSAW II) A TWO DAY CONFERENCE OF LEADERS OF LEFT- WING YOUTH HAS BEGUN IN WARSAW. A PROPOSAL HAS BEEN PUT FORWARD THAT THE FUTURE ORGANIZATION OF WORKER, INTELLIGENTSIA AND STUDENT YOUTH SHOULD BE CALLED THE UNION' OF SOCIALIST YOUTH.

(2300 HRS) THE NECESSITY OF SAVING COAL HAS BROUGHT ABOUT A CONSIDERABLE WORSENING OF CONDITIONS IN RAIL TRAVEL. WANTON DAMAGE OF ROLLING STOCK AGGRAVATES THE SITUATION STILL MORE. FURTHER DELAYS ARE CAUSED BY HEAVY SNOW FALLS.

(2015 HRS WARSAW II) STEFAN JEDRYCHOWSKI DISCUSSES IN AN INTERVIEW THE CHARACTER OF TASKS OF THE PLANNING COMMISSION OF WHICH HE HAS BEEN NAMED HEAD.

(1900 HRS WARSAW II) THE PROGRAM ATTACKED THE LONDON POLISH DAILY. SPEAKING OF ZYGMUNT NOWAKOWSKI, IT SAID THAT IT IS ALLEGED THAT SINCE HE TOOK MONEY FROM FREIES EUROPA, HE REJECTS ANYTHING CONNECTED WITH THE HOMELAND.

(2300 HRS) THE PIANIST ARTUR RUBINSTEIN HAS EXPRESSED WILLINGNESS TO VISIT POLAND.

HUNGARIAN MONITORING HIGHLIGHTS JAN. 2-3, 1956 KOSSUTH RADIO UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED

HOMELAND (SZULOEFOELDUNK) BROADCAST

(JAN. 2, 2000 HRS.) DISTRIBUTION OF RED CROSS AID IS IN PROGRESS IN ALL BUDAPEST DISTRICTS SINCE DEC. 20. 45,000 PACKAGES WERE DISTRIBUTED IN 10 DAYS. -

COMMENTARY: THE GOVERNMENT, WHICH IS NOW IN POWER TWO MONTHS. IS MAKING STRENUOUS EFFORTS AT DEMOCRATIZATION. A SERIES OF MEASURES HAVE BEEN AIMED AT CORRECTING THE MISTAKES OF THE RAKOSI REGIME. THE ECONOMIC SITUATION CONTINUES TO BE VERY GRAVE, MAKING NECESSARY FURTHER MEASURES SUCH AS LIMITATION OF BUREAUCRACY. - PUBLIC OPINION AWAITS THE GOVERNMENT PROGRAM WHICH IS EXPECTED TO BE MADE PUBLIC SOON, AND WHICH WILL SHOW THE WAY AHEAD.

ECONOMIC SITUATION

(JAN. 2, 1840 HRS.) MISKOLC RADIO SAID THAT THE PRODUCTION SITUATION IN THE BORSOD COAL MINES HAS SHOWN NO SIGN OF IMPROVEMENT IN THE LAST DAYS OF 1956. ON DEC. 30, COAL OUTPUT IN THE OZD MINES WAS 1,329 TONS, IN BORSOD 2,815 TONS. ON JAN. 2, ONLY 1,169 MINERS REPORTED FOR WORK.

(JAN. 2, 1700 HRS.) ESTI HIRLAP REPORTS THAT 2,600 MINERS WENT DOWN THE PITS IN TATABANYA ON JAN. 2, AND ABOUT HALF THAT NUMBER REPORTED FOR THE SECOND SHIFT IN THE AFTERNOON. THE EFFECTS OF THE NEW WAGES SYSTEM INTRODUCED IN DECEMBER CAN ALREADY BEEN FELT. PRODUCTION IS

BEING STEPPED UP IN THE INOTA POWER STATION.

(JAN. 2, 2000 HRS.) THE GOVERNMENT HAS APPROVED THE PECS WORKERS' COUNCIL PROPOSAL THAT 500 DWELLINGS BE BUILT FOR MINERS IN THE AREA. THE COUNCIL HAS ALSO STRESSED THAT THE MINING TRUST SHOULD HAVE GREATER INDEPENDENCE OF THE MINISTRY. THE DISMISSAL OF OFFICIALS WHO DO NOT ENJOY THE MINERS' CONFIDENCE, INCLUDING THE DIRECTOR, HAS ALSO BEEN PROPOSED.

(2200 FRS.) FORMER MEMBERS OF COLLECTIVE FARMS IN THE BARANYA COUNTY ARE RETURNING TO COOPERTIVES AFTER HAVING SEEN THE POSITIVE ANNUAL ACCOUNTING. AT PRESENT, ONLY 72 OF THE COUNTY'S 242 COLLECTIVES

ARE FUNCTIONING, BUT SOME ARE BEING REVIVED.

(1800 HRS.) A NEW FEATURE WEEKLY PROGRAM CALLED "FROM THE ACTIVITIES OF WORKERS' COUNCILS" INTRODUCED A ROUND-TABLE TALK OF SEVERAL COUNCIL MEMBERS. ONE MEMBER SAID THAT DIRECTORS SHOULD NOT BE APPOINTED BY THE MINISTRY; ANOTHER OBJECTED THAT THIS WOULD LEAD TO IT WAS AGREED THAT NEW METHODS OF CENTRAL CONTROL AND LEADERSHIP ARE NEEDED; DUE TO THE EXTRAORDINARY STUATION, CENTRAL DIRECTION OF A TEMPORARY CHARACTER HAS TO BE INTRODUCED.

SURVEY OF DAMAGE IN BUDAPEST (JAN. 3, 0700 HRS - RADIO KOSSUTH) A SURVEY CONDUCTED BY THE BUDAPEST DISTRICT COUNCILS REVEALS THAT DAMAGES ARISEN FROM THE UPRISING AMOUNT TO ALMOST 700 MILLION FORINTS IN BUDAPEST ALONE. AMOUNT INCLUDES DAMAGES DONE TO DWELLING FOUSES, PUBLIC BUILDINGS, SCHOOLS AND POSPITALS. INCLUDED IN THIS AMOUNT OF 700 MILLION FORINTS IS ALSO AN AMOUNT OF 260 MILLION FORINTS WHICH REPRESENTS THE DAMAGES TRADE SUFFERED (DAMAGES TO DEPARTMENT STORES, WAREHOUSES, ETC.)
