(JAN.30, 1900 HRS) THE GOVERNMENT DELEGATION VISITING THE

USSR DIVIDED INTO THREE GROUPS WHICH ARE VISITING

SOVIET CITIES AND ENTERPRIZES. ONE GROUP, HEADED BY NOVOTNY,
IS VISITING SVERDLOVSK, A SECOND ONE LED BY ZAPOTOCKY LENINGRAD,
AND THE THIRD ONE HEADED BY PREMIER SIROKY IS IN KIEV. NEWSCASTS

BROUGHT REPORTS ON THEIR ARRIVAL IN THE THREE SOVIET CITIES.—

SIROKY, SPEAKING ON HIS ARRIVAL IN KIEV, MENTIONED TIES BINDING

THE TWO COUNTRIES.—HE SAID RELATIONS BETWEEN THE USSR AND

CZECHOSLOVAKIA CAN BE CALLED A MODEL OF SOCIALIST RELATIONS

1. THURSDAY MORNING NEWSCASTS (JAN.J1, 0600, 0800 HRS) THE FRENCH CP DELEGATION VISITED THE NOWOTKO WORKS IN WARSAW, ACCOMPANIED BY CC SECRETARY GIEREK. - GDR AMBASSADOR STEFAN HEIMANN PAID A FAREWELL VISIT TO FOREIGN MINISTER RAPACKI.

2. GEDE ARRIVES IN MOSCOW (JAN.30. 0600 HRS) NEW POLISH AMBASSADOR TO THE SOVIET UNION, TADEUSZ GEDE, HAS ARRIVED IN THE SOVIET CAPITAL.

3. HOME NEWS (JAN. 30) (1740 HRS SZCZECIN) FURTHER WITNESSES WERE EXAMINED IN THE SZCZECIN TRIAL, THE MILITIA COMMANDER IN SZCZECIN SAID THAT THE MILITIA DID NOT HAVE SUFFICIENT STRENGTH TO LIQUIDATE THE RIOTERS. - PROF. SZCZURKIEWICZ GAVE EVIDENCE AS AN EXPERT.

(0600 HRS) A "MISS BALTIC COAST" FOR 1957 HAS BEEN ELECTED IN GDYNIA.

4. FOREIGN RELATIONS (JAN. 30) (1284 HRS) A POLISH CULTURAL DELEGATION HEADED BY MINISTER OF CULTURE KAROL KURYLUK LEFT WARSAW FOR MOSCOW. IT IS EXPECTED THAT DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS BETWEEN POLAND AND JAPAN WILL SOON BE NORMALIZED.

(1500 HRS) DELIVERIES OF SOVIET GRAIN CONTINUE TO ARRIVE IN POLAND. 150,000 TONS HAVE ALREADY ARRIVED SINCE THE

H U N G A R I A N MONITORING HIGHLIGHTS JAN. 30-31, 1957 KOSSUTH RADIO UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED

1. KADAR SPEECH AT CSEPEL

(JAN.30, 2400 HRS) EXCERPTS WERE BROADCAST FROM A SPEECH MADE BY JANOS KADAR AT AN ACITIVISTS' MEETING OF THE TEMPORARY EXECUTIVE COMMITTEE OF THE CSEPEL PARTY ORGANIZATION ON SUNDAY. (FURTHER EXCERPTS WERE BROADCAST AT 0700 HRS, JAN.31.)
KADAR SAID THAT IN PAST YEARS GRAVE MISTAKES WERE COMMITTED AND PRINCIPLES OF SOCIALISM OFTEN VIOLATED. THESE MISTAKES MUST BE REMEDIED, AND WORKERS MUST NOT TOLERATE CERTAIN FAULTS AND SHORTCOMINGS BEING TAKEN ADVANTAGE OF BY THE ENEMY AND USED AS PRETEXT FOR OPEN OR CAMOUFLAGED ATTACKS AGAINST THE REGIME. THE REACTION HAS CHANGED ITS TACTICS AND TRIES TO SPLIT COMMUNISTS BY VARIOUS LIES AND CALUMNIES .-SPEAKING OF RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION, KADAR ATTACKED THOSE WHO NOW PERSECUTE CHILDREN WHO DO NOT ENROLL FOR RELIGIOUS INSTRUCTION. THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION FIRST INVOLVED MEN IN BATTLES, THEN TRIED TO WIN OVER WOMEN AND NOW IS FALLING BACK ON CHILDREN.-DEALING WITH WORKERS' COUNCILS, KADAR SAID THE RESIGNATION OF THE CSEPEL COUNCIL SERVED THE ENDS OF COUNTER-REVOLUTION, AND NOT THE WORKERS. THE COUNCILS WERE SET UP DURING THE COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY TROUBLES, AND THIS ENABLED VARIOUS HOSTILE ELEMENTS TO INFILTRATE THEM. THEIR ACTIVITIES CAN BE FRUITFUL AND USEFUL ONLY IF THEY ARE GUIDED BY THE PARTY. IT IS CLEAR THAT THIS CANNOT BE ACHIEVED THROUGH ORDERS, BUT ONLY THROUGH THE DEVOTED WORK OF ACTIVISTS. WITHOUT THE PARTY, WORKERS CAN NEITHER RISE TO POWER, NOR MAINTAIN IT, KADAR STRESSED.THE EVENTS OF OCT.23 PROVED THIS: TREASON WEAKENED THE PARTY, SO THAT IT COULD NOT INFLUENCE EVENTS .-SPEAKING OF FUTURE PARTY TASKS, KADAR SAID THE PROGRAM AND STATUTES OF THE PARTY MUST BE WORKED OUT AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. EVEN IF THE PARTY FAILS IN BECOMING A PARTY OF THE MASSES, IT WILL CERTAINLY BE A STRONG AND UNITED PARTY, THE DEFENDER OF THE PEOPLE'S INTERESTS. - HE SAID THE PARTY NOW HAS 150,000 MEMBERS .- THE PARTY'S IDEOLOGICAL PURITY MUST BE DEFENDED. AN END MUST BE PUT TO VIEWS THAT EITHER THE YOUTH OR INTELLECTUALS ARE THE GUIDING FORCE, AND NOT THE WORKERS.

KADAR ATTACKED THE SECRETARIAN POLICY OF RAKOSI
AND THE POLICY OF THE IMRE NAGY-LOSONCZY GROUP,
TRAITORS OF THE WORKING CLASS. CARE MUST BE TAKEN THAT
A DUPLICITY OF VIEWS SHOULD NOT AGAIN CONFUSE THE RANKS
OF THE PARTY. THE PESSIMISM OF SOME PEOPLE IS NOT JUSTIFIED:
IT DEPENDS ON OURSELVES ALONE, HOW SOON WE END OUR
DIFFICULTIES.

2. SPEECH BY DOEGEI

(JAN. 30. 2200 HRS) MINISTER OF AGRICULTURE IMRE DOEGEI SPOKE AT A MEETING OF THE NATIONAL AGRICULTURAL COUNCIL. HE SAID THE EVENTS FOLLOWING OCT.23 WERE COUNTER-REVOLUTION FROM THE START, THOUGH NOT EVERYBODY WAS A COUNTER-REVOLUTIONARY. THE IMPERIALISTS ARE TRYING TO SPLIT THE SOCIALIST CAMP BY EXAGGERATING STALIN'S MESTAKES. STALIN'S LIFE MUST BE CORRECTLY APPRAISED - ALTHOUGH HE COMMITTED SERIOUS MISTAKES. STALIN WAS A GREAT MARXIST REVOLUTIONARY. STALINISM ABOVE ALL MEANS COMMUNISM, MARXISM AND LENINISM. -

DOEGEI ALSO CRITICIZED THE LEADERSHIP OF THE NATIONAL UNION OF COOPERATIVES, WHICH HAD FOR A LONG TIME OPPOSED THE KADAR GOVERNMENT. (N DOEGEI'S SUGGESTION, MOLTAN VAS AND SEVERAL OTHERS WERE RECALLED FROM THE LEADERSHIP.
