C Z E C H O'S L O V A K --- RUDE PRAVO EDITORIAL OF FEB.1 SAID
THAT WESTERN PROPAGANDA CALLS CZECHOSLOVAKIA A SATELLITE BECAUSE OF
WESTERN ANNOYANCE THAT IT IS NOW FREE OF CAPITALIST AND IMPERIALIST
FETTERS.
THE GOVERNMENT DELEGATION CONCLUDED ITS MOSCOW VISIT AND LEFT
FOR PRAGUE. A COMMUNIQUE, SIGNED BY KHRUSHCHEV AND NOVOTNY, WAS
ISSUED AT THE CONCLUSION OF TALKS BETWEEN THE TWO COMMUNIST PARTIES.

WUSSIAN HIGHLIGHTS --- JAN. 31, FEB. 1, 1957

CZECHOSLOVAKIA. VOROSHILOV AND ZAPOTOCKY SPOKE (SEE TASS REPORTS) .-

MOSCOU (JAN 31, 2208 HRS) CARRIED THE TEXT OF THE JOINT USER - CZECHOSLOVAK STATEMENT ON THE TALKS. THE STATEMENT STRESSES INTER ALIA THAT BOTH DELEGATION CONSIDER IT NECESSARY TO DEVOTE SPECIAL ATTENTION TO THE SERIOUS MENACE TO PEACE AND SECURITY INTENSIFIED IN CONNECTION WITH MEASURES TAKEN BY IMPERIALIST CIRCLES FOR SPEEDING UP REMILITARIZATION IN WESTERN GERMANY. 2. D O M E S T I C N E W S.MOSCOW (JAN 31, 2230 HRS), THE SCIENTIFIC SESSION OF THE
BRANCH OF THE USSR ACADEMY OF SCIENCES TOOK PLACE IN
KAZAN TO DISCUSS THE PROSPECTS OF DEVELOPMENT OF COAL
INDUSTRY ON THE TERRITORY OF TATARIA. DEPOSITS OF PIT - COAL
ARE ESTIMATED AT BILLIONS OF TOWS.

MOSCON (JAN 31, 2230 HRS) THE ALL- UNION CONFERENCE ON PRODUCTION OF HYBRID MAIZE SEED OPENED IN OBESSA TODAY. C Z E C H O S L O V A K MONITORING HIGHLIGHTS JAN. 31-FEB. 1, 1957 PRAGUE I UNLESS OTHERWISE INDICATED

1. RUDE PRAVO EDITORIAL ENTITLED "THE HISTORIC IMPORTANCE OF THE MOSCOW TALKS" (FEB.1, 0510 HRS) THE EDITORIAL DISCUSSED THE MOSCOW NEGOTIATIONS. HELD IN A SPIRIT OF MUTUAL UNDERSTANDING

AND AGREEMENT. THERE ARE PEOPLE, ESPECIALLY IN THE WEST, WHO FIND IT DIFFICULT TO UNDERSTAND SUCH SINCERITY, FRANKNESS AND FRATERNAL SPIRIT IN RELATIONS BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES. THEY JUDGE BY THEIR OWN PRACTICES. THE CAPITALISTS. WHO AT EVERY TURN TRY TO TRICK EACH OTHER, TAKE ADVANTAGE OF A PARTNER'S WEAKNESS AND RUTHLESSLY SQUEEZE HIM OUT, CHARGE THAT WE DO NOT ACT FREELY, THAT WE ARE A SATELLITE STATE. THE TRUTH IS THAT THEY ARE GREATLY ANNOYED THAT WE ESCAPED THE PRE-WAR FETTERS WHICH BOUND US TO ENGLAND AND FRANCE, WHEN WE HAD TO PAY A TRAGIC PRICE FOR OUR ALLIANCE. THAT IS WHY WE ARE BUILDING UP A NEW RELATIONSHIP ON THE BASIS OF AN ALLIANCE WITH THE USSR.—THE EDITORIAL GOES ON TO CHARGE THE AMERICAN IMPERIALISTS WITH THINKING UP NEW METHODS OF FORCING THEIR RULE ON VARIOUS PARTS OF THE WORLD. THEY SEE RICH POSSIBILITIES IN THE MIDDLE EAST, AND THAT IS WHY THEY THOUGHT UP THE EISENHOWER DOCTRINE.—

2. MOSCOW VISIT CONCLUDED

(JAN.31, 1230, 1900, 2200 HRS) ALL THREE GROUPS OF THE CZECHOSLOVAK GOVERNMENT DELEGATION RETURNED TO MOSCOW. THE GROUP HEADED BY ZAPOTOCKY WAS GREETED BY MIKOYAN. - BEFORE THE DELEGATION'S DEPARTURE FOR HOME, A RALLY OF SEVERAL THOUSAND MUSCOVITES WAS HELD IN THE KREMLIN, AT WHICH ALL CZECHOSLOVAK DELEGATES AND THE SOVIET LEADERSHIP WEED PRESENT. VOR OSHILOV GREETED THE DELEGATES, REVIEWING CZSL-SOVIET RELATIONS IN THE PAST, AND POINTED OUT THAT CZECHOSLOVAKIA HAS ONE OF THE HIGHEST LIVING STANDARDS IN EUROPE. EVERYBODY NOT BLINDED BY IMPERIALIST PROPAGANDA UNDERSTANDS THAT THE SOCIALIST ROAD IS THE ONLY RIGHT ONE FOR CZECHOSLOVAKIA. HE ALSO MENTIONED THE BANKRUPTCY OF IMPERIALIST POLICIES IN EGYPT AND HUNGARY AND EXPRESSED "DEEP SATISFACTION" THAT CZECHOSLOVAKIA TOOK A BASICALLY CORRECT ATTITUDE TO THE HUNGARIAN EVENTS.

THE CZSL DELEGATION LEFT MOSCOW AT 1800 HRS. IT WAS SEEN OFF BY SOVIET LEADERS, INCLUDING VOROSHILOV, BULGANIN, KHRUSHCHEV.-

A COMMUNIQUE WAS ISSUED IN MOSCOW AT THE CONCLUSION OF THE CZSL-SOVIET PARTY TALKS. IT WAS SIGNED BY NOVOTNY AND KHRUSHCHEV. THE TWO PARTIES EXCHANGED INFORMATION ON THEIR PRESENT SITUATION AND DISCUSSED QUESTIONS OF MUTUAL INTEREST. THE GREAT IMPORTANCE OF THE 20TH CONGRESS AND THE JUNE CZSL CP CONFERENCE WAS STRESSED. DURING THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION IN HUNGARY, BOTH PARTIES UNANIMOUSLY CAME OUT IN SUPPORT OF THE REVOLUTIONARY FORCES OF THE HUNGARIAN PEOPLE. THE SOVIET UNION FULFILLED ITS INTERNATIONAL DUTY TO THE HUNGARIAN PEOPLE. WHILE THE CZECHOSLOVAK PEOPLE SHOWED REVOLUTIONARY THIS WAS A GREAT HELP TO THE HEALTHY REVOLUTIONARY FORCES OF THE HUNGARIAN PEOPLE. - THE TWO PARTIES ARE AGREED THAT THE HEIGHTENED INTERNATIONAL TENSION DEMANDS GREATER VIGILANCE ON THE PART OF COMMUNIST AND WORKERS* PARTIES. BOTH PARTIES WILL TAKE THE NECESSARY MEASURES IN THIS CONNECTION. THEY POINT OUT THAT PEACE AND SECURITY ARE BEING INCREASINGLY ENDANGERED BY THE IMPERIALISTS .-THE DECLARATION GOES ON TO STRESS THE UNITY OF THE SOCIALIST CAMP, AND THE USEFULINESS OF TALKS BETWEEN THE VARIOUS COMMUNIST PARTIES. WITH THAT IN MIND, BOTH PARTIES AGREED TO HAVE EVEN MORE CLOSE AND REGULAR CONTACT.

JEDRYCHOWSKI. TOTAL PRODUCTION IS TO GROW BY 4,2 PERCENT.

COAL OUTPUT HAS BEEN SET AT 93 MILLION TONS - 2,150,000 LESS THAN
IN 1956, PRODUCTION OF FOUNDRIES IS TO GROW BY 6,7 PERCENT, ELECTRIC
POWER BY 11 PERCENT, PRODUCTION IN CHEMICAL INDUSTRY,
14 PERCENT. GENERAL INCREASE OF PRODUCTION IS FORESEEN IN THE LIGHT
