(FEB 19,0510 PRS) UNDER THE HEADLINE:

"TUROUGH EYES OF AN ECONOMIST"

TODAY'S RUDE PRAVO PUBLISHES AN EDITORIAL WHICH CALLS ON ALL CZSL WORKERS TO ECONOMIZE THE PRODUCTION. THE EDITORIAL GIVES AN EXAMPLE OF A WELDER FROM PLZEN WHOSE GREATEST INTEREST IT WAS TO TRANSMIT HIS EXPERIENCE TO OTHER FELLOW WORKERS AS SOON AS POSSIBLE. THE EDITORIAL CALLS ESPECIALLY ON ALL DEVISING CONSTRUCTORS TO REDUCE THE WEIGHT OF THE NEW MAC, INES AND CONSERVE MUCH NEEDED MATERIAL FOR OTHER PURPOSES. ALSO THE RESPONSIBILITY OF LEADING MANAGERS MUST INCREASE ESPE-CIALLY WHERE THE QUALITY OF PRODUCTS IS CONCERNED.
