# CZECHOSLOVAK:

RUDE PRAVO EDITORIAL OF TODAY DISCUSSES THE FAVOURABLE CONDITIONS CREATED BY THE CZSL GOVERNMENT FOR "HEALTHY GROWING" OF THE YOUTH. LACK OF ACTIVITY OF SOME PARTY ORGANIZATIONS
REGARDING THE YOUTH IS ALSO CRITICIZED.
"SIMPLE INTERVIEWS" WILL BE INTRODUCED AT SECONDARY SCHOOLS, COLLEGES
AND UNIVERSITIES INSTEAD OF EXAMINATIONS FOR ACCEPTION OF STUDENTS.

# POLISH:

ACCORDING TO REPORTS FROM PARLIAMENTARY CIRCLES, JAROSZEWICZ AND IGNAR ARE EXPECTED TO HAVE THE FUNCTIONS OF VICE-PREMIERS IN THE NEW GOVERNMENT.

KOTLICKI TOLD A PRESS CONFERENCE IN NEW YORK THAT POLAND IS INTERESTED IN OBTAINING CREDITS FOR COTTON AND MACHINERY, ESPECIALLY MINING MACHINERY. - MINISTER OF FOREIGN TRADE TRAMPCZYNSKI SAID IN MOSCOW THAT THE POLISH - SOVIET TRADE NEGOTIATIONS ARE EXPECTED TO LAST A MONTH.

(FEB 22 0510 HRS) RUDE PRAVO EDITORIAL OF TODAY ENTITLED

"YOUTH- OUR HAPPINESS AND CONCERN"

STRESSES THE GOOD CARE GIVEN TO THE CZSL. YOUTH BY THE REGIME.
DIFFERENT CONDITIONS ARE FOR EXAMPLE IN CANADA WHERE, ACCORDING
TO REUTER, CZSL. REFUGEE OTTO CIZEK OFFERED HIS 6 CHILDREN FOR
SALE BECAUSE HE WAS NOT ABLE TO FIND WORK SINCE 1949- SINCE HIS
ARRIVAL TO CANADA.

IN CSR MANY MODERN INSTITUTIONS TAKE CARE FOR CHILDREN AND A FAMILY WITH 6 CHILDREN IS GETTING 930 CROWNS FOR THEIR SUPPORT FROM THE STATE.

THE EDITORIAL FURTHER RECALLS ALL THE WORKS WHERE THE YOUNG PEOPLE TOOK PARTY IN THE CONSTRUCTION AND BUILDING / IN THE BORDER AREAS, BUILDING OF DAMS, FOUNDRIES, ETC/ AND STRESSES THAT THE CZSL. YOUTH IS GROWING IN HEALTHY CONDITIONS.

SOMEWHERE THE PARTY ORGANIZATIONS STILL DO NOT CARE MUCH FOR THE ACTIVITY OF YOUNG PEOPLE, "SOMEWHERE WE CANNOT BE SATISIFIED WITH THE EDUCATION".

FOR EXAMPLE, IN RECKOVICE NEAR BENO, THE YOUTH UNION DOES NOT HAVE ENOUGH NEARS FOR ITS ACTIVITY- ONLY ONCE A WEEK A MEETING IN THE HOUSE OF CULTURE; ON THE OTHER HAND, THE LOCAL CHAPL: ARRANGED MEETINGS OF THE YOUTH IN THE SACRISTY AND ALLOWED THE YOUGH PEOPLE TO PLAY TALB ETENNIS THERE.

IN CONCLUSION THE EDITORIAL CALLS ON EVERYONE TO ELIMINATE THE "IMPROPER CONDITIONS IN THE EDUCATION".

#### 1. SEJM SESSION

(FEB 21 2000 HRS WARSAW II) A GROUP OF 30 INDEPENDENT DEPUTIES, INCLUDING EDMUND OSMANCZYK, IS TO FORM ITS OWN PARLIAMENTARY CLUB UNDER THE NAME OF "OCTOBER 21 CLUB".

(FEB 22 8628 HRS) THE MAIN SUBJECTS OF DISCUSSION IN
MP CIRCLES ARE THE COMPOSITION OF THE NEW GOVERNMENT, AND
BILLS TO BE DISCUSSED BY THE SEJM. THE FUNCTIONS OF VICE-PREMIERS
ARE EXPECTED TO BE.
FILLED BY JAROSZEWICZ AND IGNAR, WHILE
ZOLKIEUSKI SI BE MINISTER OF HIGHER EDUCATION. NO DECISIONS
HAVE BEEN MADE ON THE POTHER POSTS, ALTHOUGH IT IS EXPECTED
THAT NON- PARTY EXPERTS WILL ALSO BELONG TO THE GOVERNMENT.WESTERN NEWSPAPERS WRITE EXTENSIVELY ON THE CURRENT SEJM
SESSION. THE TIMES STRESSES THE FACT THAT IN THE
ELECTION OF HIGHER ORGANS THERE ALSO WERE VOTES AGAINST SOME
CANDIDATES, WHILE OTHER DEPUTIES ABSTAINED. LIBERATION POINTS
OUT THAT GOMULKA NOW HAS AN OFFICIAL STATE FUNCTION THROUGH
LES ELECTION OF ZAWIEYSKI TO THE COUNCIL OF STATE IS OF PARTICULAR
SIGNIFICANCE SINCE IT WILL REASSURE BOTH CATHOLIC INTELLECTUALS

# 2. FRIDAY MORNING NEWSCASTS

(FEB 22 0600 HRS 0800 HRS) HEAD OF THE POLISH BELEGATION TO WASHINGTON, KOTLICKI, TOLD A PRESS CONFERENCE IN NEW YORK THAT POLAND IS INTERESTED IN OBTAINING CREDITS FOR COTTON AND MACHINERY, ESPECIALLY MINING MACHINERY. THE POLISH BELEGATE TO THE UN HAS PROTESTED TO THE AMERICAN DELEGATE; CABOT LODGE IN THE CASE OF DR. RAJCHMAN, A POLISH REPRESENTATIVE TO A UN CATALLESION. WHO WAS CALLED TO TESTIEY AT THE AMERICAN

CONGRESSIONAL INTERNAL SECURITY COMMITTEE. AN ITALIAN-YUGOSLAV TRADE AGREEMENT HAS BEEN SIGNED IN ROME.

3. TRADE DELEGATION IN MOSCOW

(FEB 21 2100 HRS) MINISTER OF FOREIGN TRADE WITOLD TRAMPCZYNSKI, WHO IS IN MOSCOW TO NEGOTIATE A POLISH - SOVIET TRADE AGREEMENT TOLD PAP THAT THE NEGOTIATIONS ARE PROGRESSING WELL. THEY ARE EXPECTED TO LAST ANOTHER MONTH.

4. OTHER NEWS

(2100 MRS) COMMISSIONS FOR MINORITY AFFAIRS HAVE BEEN LSTABLISHED IN THE CC OF PZPR AND IN THE VOIEVCDSHIP COMMITTEES OF THE PARTY. THE MAIN COMMISSION IS HEADED BY WITOLD JAROSINSKI.

(0015 RRS) ZBIGNIEW FLORCZAK ANNOUNCED IN THE "REAJ" BADIO PROGRAM THAT THE "HOMELAND" BULLETIN WOULD CEASE PUBLICATION.

(2120 HRS) THE POLISH WRITER ZOFIA KOSSAK- SZCZUCKA ON THURSDAY RETURNED TO POLAND FROM EXILE. SHE WAS WARNLY GREETED AT THE WARSAW AIRPORT BY A LARGE CROWD.

(0600 HRS) THE NEWSCAST REPORTED ON TWO BROTHERS WHO JERRORIZED THE CREW OF A FISHING TRALVER, SEIZED THE VESSEL AND LANDED IN BORNHOLM.

(2150 HRS) THE PROGRAM "FIVE MINUTES ON EDUCATION" SAID THAT TEACHERS WHO CONSIDER THAT THEY ARE THERE COLY TO TEACH (SINCE THIS IS REQUIRED BY THE PROGRAM) AND NOT TO EDUCATE AND BRING UP CHILDREN SHOULD SNAP OUT OF THEIR INDIFFERENCE TOWARDS THE CHILD.

(2300 HRS) THE MINISTRY OF MACHINE INDUSTRY HAS BEEN REORGANIZED.

(2000 HRS WARSAW II) DEPUTY WEST GERMAN SOCIALIST LEADER GARLO SCHMIDT HAS PROPOSED THAT WEST GERMAN ESTABLISH DIPLOMATIC RELATIONS WITH POLAND.

## 5. ON COMMUNIST MORALITY

C1820 HRS) A TALK BY HENRY JANKOUSKI DEMANDED THAT THE SYSTEM OF COMMUNIST MORALITY BE REVISED FROM THE HUMANISTIC POINT OF VIEW SO THAT IT MIGHT INCLUDE MORAL NORMS MAKING THE INDIVIDUAL AND END IN ITSELF. WE MUST REJECT THE PATTERN WHEREBY THE GOOD OF THE INDIVIDUAL IS THE GOOD OF THE MASSES WHICH IN TURN IS THE GOOD OF THE STATE. THE PRACTICE OF SUBCRDINATING INDIVIDUAL INTERESTS TO THE STATE WAS NO MORE THAN A SUBSERVIENCE TO BUREAUCRACY. THE PRACTICE OF MAKING A FETISH OF THE STATE AND INSTITUTIONS OF ALL SORTS WAS IN FACT A CONTRADICTION OF THE IDEALS OF SOCIALISM AND OF THE INTERESTS OF THE MASSES.

### 2. GOVERNMENT MEETING

(FEB. 21, 2000 MRS.) AT ITS MEETING TODAY, THE GOVERNMENT APPROVED A RESOLUTION OF THE TASKS AND ORGANIZATION OF THE MINISTRY OF EDUCATION. THE MINISTRY WILL COMPRISE THREE MAIN ORGANIZATIONAL UNITS: FOR EDUCATION, CULTURE AND CHURCH AFFAIRS. THE OFFICE FOR PHYSICAL TRAINING AND SPORTS WILL OPERATE AS AN IMPERENDENT OFFICE UNDER THE SUPERVISION OF THE MINISTRY.

THE GOVERNMENT ALSO APPROVED A RESOLUTION ON THE REORGANIZATION OF MACHINE STATIONS AS INDEPENDENT ACCOUNTING ENTERPRIZES; IT DECREED THAT THE TEMPORARY ALLOCATION OF FLATS MADE BETWEEN OCT. 23 AND FEB.15 MUST BE REVISED; IT APPROVED BUDAPEST CITY COUNCIL PLANS FOR RESTORATION OF THE SOVIET MERCES' MEMORIALS IN BUDAPEST WHICH WERE DAMAGED DURING THE COUNTER-REVOLUTION.

# 3. STATEMENT ON RELATIONS WITH AUSTRIA

(FEB. 21, 2200 HRS.) THE FOREIGN MINISTRY HAS ISSUED A STATEMENT ON HUNGARIAN-AUSTRIAN RELATIONS STRESSING THAT THE GOVERNMENT OF HUNGARY IS CONSTANTLY STRIVING TO PROMOTE AND ADVANCE MUTUAL COOPERATION, WHILE THE AUSTRIAN GOVERNMENT IS CONSTANTLY TAKING STEPS OFFENDING THE PRINCIPLES OF NORMAL RELATIONS BETWEEN THE TWO COUNTRIES. ANTI-HUNGARIAN PROPAGANDA IS TOLERATED, AND MONOPOLISTIC ASSOCIATES IN AUSTRIA (LIKE HELMER AND GRAF) ARE CONSTANTLY TRYING TO FOISON THE INTERNATIONAL ATMOSPHERE. - THE STATEMENT ATTACKS THE FACT OF NIXON'S VISIT, RAAB'S RECENT RADIO ADDRESS AND OBSTACLES PLACED IN THE WAY OF AUSTRO-HUNGARIAN SPORTS AND CULTURAL RELATIONS.
