PLAN SHORT COMINGS."HOWEVER, MINISTRY OF COMMUNICATION MEANS UP TO NOW HAS ALLOWED MAJOR ERRORS IN PLANNING, HAS POORLY COORDINATED THE GOODS

DELAYS OF TRAINS IS FAR FROM BEING MAINTAINED IN ALL DISTRICTS. THERE IS A GREAT NUMBER OF CASES OF DELAYS EN ROUTE. EVEN THE TIGH TASKS OF THE COMSTRUCTION WORKERS CANNOT SATISFY THE DEEDS FOR APARTMENT BUITS. FOR EXAMPLE, LAST YEAR'S PRODUCTION WOULD HAVE TO BE MORE THAN DOUBLED TO SATISFY THE GROWING NEEDS OF OUR POPULATION.

THE KEY PROPLEM LILS IN "INDUSTRIALIZING" OF THE CZSL. BHILDING AND CONSTRUCTION INDUSTRY. IN THIS FIELD FAR MORE COULD HAVE BEEN DONE IN THE PAST YEAR.

RECENT CCCP RESOLUTION INSTRUCTS EMPLOYEES OF THE CONSTRUCTION MINISTRY TO INTRODUCE SO-CALLED STREAMLINE BHILDING" WHICH SMOUND INCREASE THE LABOUR PRODUCTIVITY AND PREPARE CONDITIONS FOR INDUSTRIAL METHODS OF CONSTRUCTION.

COOD EXAMPLE OF "STREAMLINE BUILDING" WAS THE CONSTRUCTION SITE DIMLA NEAR PARDUBICE WHERE A HOUSING BLOC WAS BUILT IN 9 MOLTHS / 12 -18 MONTHS WAS THE AVERAGE SOMEWHERE ELSE/, HIGHER LIFETH FROMEGTIVITY WAS REACHED AND THE WORKERS WERE EARATHG 30 FERCENT MORE THAN SOMEWHERE ELSE. THE MINISTRY FOUNDED A CONSTRUCTION SCHOOL HERE AND IN A YEAR OF ITS OPERATION MORE THAN 1,800 EXPERTS GRADUATED ROMTHIS SCHOOL.

"THE GRAVITY POINT" LIES IN FRE-FABRICATION OF THE PRODUCTION MATERIAL.
